



CROCHET INSTRUCTIONS

Use a size M hook.

Chain 54 stitches or desired width of shawl.

Chain 1 & turn. Single crochet in each of the stitches to the end.

Chain 3 & turn. Double crochet in top of each single crochet. Repeat this row 2 more times.

Chain 1 & do 1 row of single crochet to the end.

Chain 3 & turn. Do 3 rows of double crochet.

Repeat pattern to the end (1 row single, 3 rows double).

End with 1 row of single. Finish with fringe (optional.)

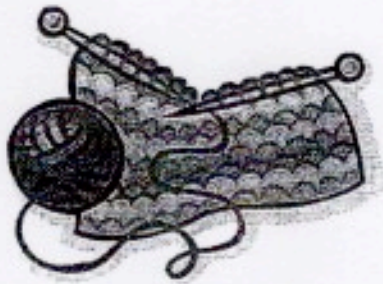
Use 3-4 skeins of yarn.

Approximate finished sizes not including fringe is about 30" by 64".

TO MAKE A HEALING SHAWL

- YARN:** Use 3 skeins of any brand but it should be washable.
- NEEDLES:** Use size 13, 15 or 17.
These needles go faster for a loose weave and they make the project go faster.
- TO BEGIN:** Cast on 63 stitches.
- PATTERN:** Knit three, purl three to the end of the row. Begin each row with knit three, purl three and continue to the end of the row. Knit until the yarn is gone.
