

I. St. Timothy's Chapel indoor weekday Masses

- a. Face masks must be worn by all during the entire Mass, except when receiving Holy Communion.
- b. Restrooms will be inaccessible/closed during Mass.
- c. The Chapel will be cleaned, and all high touch areas disinfected at the end of every day.
- d. Additionally, those who attend Mass in the Chapel will be provided sanitizing/disinfecting wet wipes to clean the areas they have occupied.
- e. The seating capacity due to social distancing for the weekday indoor Masses at St. Timothy's Chapel will be limited to 18 unrelated individuals (anyone outside of a person's immediate household) and up to a maximum of 25 related and unrelated individuals.
- f. Pews will be clearly marked to indicate where it is and where it is not permissible to sit, to help you maintain the 6 feet of social distancing.
- g. For Holy Communion, the faithful will remain in their pews.
 - The priest will sanitize his hands prior to distributing Holy Communion.
 - The priest, wearing face mask and shield, will approach you and stop approximately 6 ft away.
 - You will remove your face mask in preparation to receive the Body of Christ.
 - The priest will say: *Body of Christ*, and you will respond: *Amen*.
- h. If the Chapel is full, or regardless, you may still park/sit outside in the parking lot and receive Holy Communion outside in the clearly marked spots.
- i. The maximum capacity for the indoor/outdoor Mass while also ensuring 6 feet of social distance in all directions, is 100 people.
- j. The Mass will be live streamed via Zoom
- k. Entrance and exit doors will be held open at the beginning and end of Mass to prevent people from touching door handles, knobs, or push plates.
- l. If weather permits, church windows will be left open to improve air circulation. We will run air conditioning systems when the weather justifies its use.
